

You should be able to login to the Walker Physics e-book account using the following set of instructions

1. Register at [www.PearsonSchool.com/Access](http://www.PearsonSchool.com/Access) { Screen shots on following pages }
  - a. Enter the first 6 letters of your code **SSNAST** click NEXT
  - b. On the next screen Click on **Covered Titles**. A dropdown list appears of subjects.
  - c. Select **SCIENCE**
  - d. A new dropdown appears listing testbooks. Select **WALKER 3<sup>rd</sup> Ed.**
  - e. A description of the book appears indicating it is for AP Physics
  - f. Choose **STUDENT REGISTRATION**
  - g. Accept - Pearson License Agreement. Select "I Accept"
  - h. Select "No" when prompted about a whether you have a Pearson Account.
  - i. Enter Access Information -

\* Enter the Student Access Code below According to the first letters of your last name
